INTRODUCTION

As we go about our daily lives, experiences from relationships, the environment, influences, and other events will sometimes prove that life can be predictably unpredictable. One moment it seems as though everyone is skipping around on a proverbial cloud in 7th heaven, then the next, someone winds up standing in the muck and mire of what you call madness. Have you found yourself asking, where is God and is anybody praying? When I've heard those questions, most of the time it was from the lips of unbelievers. I've heard it from some who profess their faith in Jesus Christ, but tend to be perpetual "babes" of the scriptures.

When I became a Christian, prayer and attending prayer gatherings became the life blood of my existence. I need to know the mind and heart of God, what He wants, thinks and feels about His creation. I search the scriptures, keep myself planted in a ministry of sound teaching, and abide in the presence of God through prayer as often as possible. The present economy has contributed to many Christians living beneath the identity and covenant declared in the Word of God. Yet it saddens my heart to know that the least attended gatherings in the church are for evangelism and corporate prayer.

I am reminded of a movie I watched with my grandchildren called "Madagascar." There was a group of penguins, not the main characters, who captured a great portion of my attention and laughter. Whenever there was a possibility of them getting unwanted attention, the penguin leader would tell the others "Smile and wave boys, just smile and wave." This instruction and adherence to it was their "rule of non-engagement." It makes me wonder if many in the Body of Christ are just "smiling and waving" at Jesus. Are they not giving themselves to studying the scriptures and prayer? Are they neglecting the necessary engagement to learn, know, understand and mature in the things of God?

When I wrote my first book "Pray What God Says," the intention was to encourage and provoke the reader to develop a greater relationship with God through prayer. The effect of communion and fellowship with Him yields the manifestation of spiritual growth and blessing in every facet of your life. The benefit of prayer is the evidence that God truly honors what is promised in His Word.

It is important to know the Word of God for effective and effectual prayer. And His Word declares who He is, what He does, who we are, and what we can have. Our greatest access to God, kingdom living, and the assistance of the Holy Spirit is through prayer. A question has been raised on various Internet social mediums and it is "Where has the power in the church gone?" I think the critics of the church fail to recognize that there is a true distinction between the godly and ungodly. It is more so when they are jaded by the human failure of a few men and women of God, who become candidates for stoning by the media and public opinion. I always pray that the people of God who have fallen step back into the redeeming grace and sure mercies of God quickly.

The benefit of Internet technology has enabled me to obtain statistics on visits to my website. One variable allows me to see what people were searching for that led them to the site. A greater percentage of the visitors want to know how to pray. If adverse circumstances are the major provocation, I am glad that seeking God through prayer is perceived as the remedy and solution. And it is!

When the church (individually and corporately) prays effective and effectual prayers, the result is power and demonstration exemplified in Joel 2:26-32: And ye shall eat in plenty, and be satisfied, and praise the name of the Lord your God, that hath dealt wondrously with you: and my people shall never be ashamed. And ye shall know that I am in the midst of Israel, and that I am the Lord your God, and none else: and my people shall never be ashamed. And it shall come to pass afterward, that I will pour out my spirit upon all flesh; and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your old men shall dream

dreams, your young men shall see visions: And also upon the servants and upon the handmaids in those days will I pour out my spirit. And I will shew wonders in the heavens and in the earth, blood, and fire, and pillars of smoke. The sun shall be turned into darkness, and the moon into blood, before the great and the terrible day of the Lord come. And it shall come to pass, that whosoever shall call on the name of the Lord shall be delivered: for in mount Zion and in Jerusalem shall be deliverance, as the Lord hath said, and in the remnant whom the LORD shall call.

There are revivals going on now throughout the earth. Lives are being changed, healed and delivered everyday by the power of God. Although I might not see prayer attendance as great as it should be, God is using a remnant of men and women who are dedicated to His Word to *Pray without ceasing*. —1Thessalonians 5:17.

"Talk to God with Affirmations of Faith," is a resource for those who want to start or develop their communication and relationship with God. The scripturally-based affirmations contained in this book will fortify the truth of God in your heart relative to any circumstance that occurs in your life. When you study the scriptures, it is in the language of Kingdom because we are Kingdom people.

Deuteronomy 14:2 — For thou art an holy people unto the LORD thy God, and the LORD hath chosen thee to be a peculiar people unto himself, above all the nations that are upon the earth.

1Peter 2:8-10 New Living Translation (NLT)— And, "He is the stone that makes people stumble, the rock that makes them fall." They stumble because they do not obey God's word, and so they meet the fate that was planned for them. But you are not like that, for you are a chosen people. You are royal priests, a holy nation, God's very own possession. As a result, you can show others the goodness of God, for he called you out of the darkness into his wonderful light. "Once you had no identity as a people; now you are God's people. Once you received no mercy; now you have received God's mercy."

Titus 2:14 (NLT)— He gave his life to free us from every kind of sin, to cleanse us, and to make us his very own people, totally commit-

ted to doing good deeds.

Living in kingdom privilege and kingdom access demands that you: Speak the Language of Kingdom and Shift from Victim to Victorious. When you do, prepare to enter into God's tangible presence where your heart will readily commit to His love, power, peace and blessings.

CHAPTER 1

Speak the Language of Kingdom

The scriptures in my introduction, Deuteronomy, 1Peter and Titus, are some of the many scriptures that tell us who we are. We are a kingdom people who are children of the Creator and joint heirs with Jesus Christ. Romans 8:17— And if children, then heirs; heirs of God, and joint-heirs with Christ; if so be that we suffer with him, that we may be also glorified together.

As kingdom people, we study the scriptures for correction, instruction, and reproof. 2Timothy 3:16— All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness.

The kingdom of God becomes the first estate to the born again Christian. Through the scriptures we learn how to communicate with Him and each other according to kingdom. You may have heard the expression "native speak" or "mother tongue" which refers to first language. It means a language a person has learned from birth or within the critical period, or that a person speaks the best and so it is often the basis for socio-linguistic identity. In some countries, the terms native language or mother tongue refer to the language of one's ethnic group rather than one's first language.

Sometimes, there can be more than one mother tongue, when the child's parents speak different languages. Those children are usually called bilingual. —Source: Wilkipedia

These definitions refer to the natural. But spiritual application of this definition has relevant significance. The language of kingdom becomes the primary tongue of the believer who studies the scriptures and builds a relationship with God through prayer. What they think, say and do will have its root and foundation in the Word of God. We are in the world but we are of the kingdom of God, so that makes us bilingual.

The Word of God tells us who we are and what access we have to great and precious kingdom promises. We are spiritual kingdom people existing in a natural world. Along with that existence is the reality of natural and spiritual trials, tribulation and afflictions.

John 16:33— These things I have spoken unto you, that in me ye might have peace. In the world ye shall have tribulation: but be of good cheer; I have overcome the world.

1John 4:4— Ye are of God, little children, and have overcome them: because greater is he that is in you, than he that is in the world.

We experience reality—the wonderful and the critical. Reality at times makes us needy, desperate, anxious, beggars who look for people and things to satisfy, approve or validate us. Sometimes out of desperation, kingdom people fail to speak our kingdom language to resolve the negative perception or reality of situations and circumstances. A major weapon the enemy uses against the people of God is affliction.

Affliction—*Affliction refers to a condition or cause of suffering.*—Definition source: Wilkipedia

Synonyms for the word affliction include: *adversity, ruin, harm, hurt, desolation, torture, torment, mishap, miscarriage, casualty, accident, reversal, disaster, tragedy, calamity, catastrophe.* These synonyms are the cause of affliction.

Suffering, grief, sorrow, sadness, anguish, anxiety, heartache, heartbreak, misery, agony, distress, wretchedness. These synonyms are the emotional results of affliction

Hardship, trouble, trial, tribulation, stress, burden, weight. And these synonyms are the effects of affliction.

When you look at the preceding list, which is not exhaustive, I am quite sure you or someone you know has experienced some, maybe all of those synonyms. When you don't know or you neglect to use your kingdom language, then satan takes advantage of your perception of the situation or affliction. When he controls your perception, then your choices, words and actions come into alignment or agreement with who he wants to be in your life. He is a liar, thief, murderer and destroyer. John 10:10— *The thief*

cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.

Then satan starts to influence you into thinking, believing, saying and doing what he says you are although he has already been defeated. Revelations 12:10— And I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, Now is come salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of his Christ: for the accuser of our brethren is cast down, which accused them before our God day and night.

And he attempts to keep you bound and illegally held captive to his devices. Revelation 13:10— He that leadeth into captivity shall go into captivity: he that killeth with the sword must be killed with the sword. Here is the patience and the faith of the saints.

Access to kingdom promises, power and deliverance is through speaking our kingdom language, the Word of God. We speak our kingdom language by utilizing the scriptures in prayers of thanksgiving, praise, worship, supplications and intercession. We also have access to the same benefits through affirmations.

Affirmation — Affirmation is a declaration that something is true. Specifically, it may refer to: in logic, the union of the subject and predicate of a proposition

Affirmative prayer— is a form of prayer or a metaphysical technique that is focused on a positive outcome rather than a negative situation. For example, a person who is experiencing some form of illness would focus the prayer on the desired state of perfect health and affirm this desired intention "as if already happened" rather than identifying the illness and then asking God for help to eliminate it. — Definition source: Wilkipedia

Synonyms for affirmation include: assertion, avowal, word, testimony, deposition, acknowledgment, announcement, allegation, ratification, approval, confirmation, corroboration, endorsement, certification, warranty.

Synonyms for affirm include: state positively, tell with confidence, declare, proclaim, make known, profess, say, pronounce, witness, bear witness, claim, hold, allege, approve, ratify, endorse, accept, establish, confirm, acknowledge, support, sustain, backup, guarantee

When you look at the list of synonyms for affirmation and affirm, this is one of the ways the language of kingdom should be spoken. Wouldn't you prefer the outcome and benefits affirming the scriptures would have over your life?

You don't have to convince God by trying to persuade Him; make Him see the light; bring Him around to win Him over; sell Him on the idea that He needs to see things your way; be assured that you need Him to move in your behalf; or prove to Him that you need Him. When you beg, plead, whine, and try to convince God, it means that you don't know that He is omniscient (all knowing), omnipresent (everywhere), and omnipotent (all powerful). God does not want you to be ignorant to who He is, what He has said He can do, who He says you are to Him, and the access you have to Him and His promises.

Study the Word of God to learn of its benefits to and for your life.

Joshua 1:8-9— This book of the law shall not depart out of thy mouth; but thou shalt meditate therein day and night, that thou mayest observe to do according to all that is written therein: for then thou shalt make thy way prosperous, and then thou shalt have good success. Have not I commanded thee? Be strong and of a good courage; be not afraid, neither be thou dismayed: for the Lord thy God is with thee whithersoever thou goest.

When you learn and know the scriptures, develop a prayer life, and speak affirmations, it prepares you for the next demand — Shift from Victim to Victorious.

CHAPTER 2 Shift from Victim to Victorious

Change Your Posture

The first step toward shifting from a victim of the enemy to a victorious life in Christ Jesus is to Change Your Posture. If a critical or negative situation occurs, you don't want to open the door for affliction. Take another look at the synonym list for affliction and review the list of emotional effects. If you are experiencing just one of them you need to change your posture in that situation.

How do you change your posture?

1. Connect to God. Often I have heard people refer to God as a "crutch" and they use the word in a negative connotation. Sometimes it is to make light of the believer's faith, trust and reliance on God, or give the impression that God relishes a following of zombie-like, dysfunctional people incapable of a significant life. Those who intend to mock us with usage of the word "crutch" fail to understand the utility and functionality of the crutch.

Crutches are mobility aids used to counter a mobility impairment or an injury that limits walking ability. —Definition source: Wilkipedia

When you have been afflicted and decide to change your posture and connect to God, He should be welcomed as a crutch. His promises are your support and strength to compensate for every weakness. He is a crutch to facilitate your physical and spiritual healing. He comes along side you for natural and spiritual development, change, growth, and maturity. God is your crutch for any situation.

2. Attract God's attention. Prayer, praise and worship gets the attention of God. When you wholeheartedly welcome God's presence, everything that He is comes into the room. So whatever is needed and necessary is found in His presence. James 4:8—Draw nigh to God, and he will draw nigh to you. Cleanse your hands, ye sinners; and purify your hearts, ye double minded.

3. Commit to God. Simply put in Deuteronomy 10:12-14—And now, Israel, what doth the Lord thy God require of thee, but to fear the Lord thy God, to walk in all his ways, and to love him, and to serve the Lord thy God with all thy heart and with all thy soul, To keep the commandments of the Lord, and his statutes, which I command thee this day for thy good? Behold, the heaven and the heaven of heavens is the Lord's thy God, the earth also, with all that therein is.

Change the Atmosphere

The atmosphere is what is occurring or what you are experiencing in your immediate space, naturally or spiritually. You can change the atmosphere by what you choose or decide to think, say and do. In the heavens, the atmosphere encompasses climate, conditions and conclusions/outcome.

- —A climate that is airy, gaseous, static, vaporous, or ethereal,
- —Creates conditions that are indistinct, cloudy, hazy, misty, or foggy.
- —The conclusions and outcomes are clear skies, storms, rain, sleet, snow, hurricane, or tornadoes.

This is the natural atmosphere. Now imagine the following scenario, and it happens frequently. But I want you to consider the spiritual climate, conditions and conclusion/outcome.

You are at work in the lunchroom with several employees. You listen quietly as the others have a general lighthearted conversation. The atmosphere is cheerful. Another employee enters the lunchroom and engages in the conversation but decides to share some gossip about the boss. Everything this person says is negative, abrasive, and full of unconfirmed accusations. The lunchroom gets very quiet because the climate of the room has changed.

—You think to yourself: I heard something similar from someone else.

This is a passive thought in a negative climate.

—You decide to share and compare what you heard.

Negative words in a negative climate creates negative conditions.

—The conclusion or outcome of this scenario is not good.

What you did is contribute to gossip. You are potentially causing others to stumble spiritually, and you marred the integrity of the person(s) you heard about, whether the gossip is true or not.

Now what can you think, say and do differently?

—Is what you heard so important that you need to share it? Reset you thoughts to a positive climate.

Philippians 4:8—Finally, brethren, whatsoever things are true, whatsoever things are honest, whatsoever things are just, whatsoever things are pure, whatsoever things are lovely, whatsoever things are of good report; if there be any virtue, and if there be any praise, think on these things.

—Do you leave the room or say nothing at all? But if you say something, does it edify, exhort, build-up?

What you say should have the potential to change the climate for a positive condition.

Romans 14:19— Let us therefore follow after the things which make for peace, and things wherewith one may edify another.

—How do you change the atmosphere so there is a positive conclusion or outcome?

Proverbs 11:13— A talebearer revealeth secrets: but he that is of a faithful spirit concealeth the matter.

1John 5:16— If any man see his brother sin a sin which is not unto death, he shall ask, and he shall give him life for them that sin not unto death. There is a sin unto death: I do not say that he shall pray for it.

When you need or decide to change the atmosphere around you, consider if the conclusions and outcomes have godly approval and godly validation. And make sure there is an open door for deliverance, elevation and promotion for you or others?

Change the Environment

You change the environment by naturally and/or spiritually changing conditions, settings, surroundings, elements, tone, moods and ambiance. It is also avoiding or removing your self from the aforementioned list if that environment is negative. Changing your environment also means not aligning with people or places that are ungodly. Don't get entangled with people who consistently demonstrate a character, spirit, temperament or feelings that the fruit of the spirit is not welcomed at all.

We are a tri-part type being. We are a spirit, we have a soul, and we live in this body. Due to the fall of Adam in the garden, we're all born with a nature to sin (the Adamic nature). The soul is your mind, will, senses, thoughts and emotions. What you think, your decisions and choices, and how you feel is governed by the soulish realm. The senses are to see, hear, smell, touch and taste. We also have free will, and when exercised, defers to self-assertiveness and self-gratification (the soul—your mind, will, senses, thoughts and emotions). Our body will follow what the soul dictates. In God's kingdom, for the born again Christian, you are considered to be ruled by the flesh, the carnal, or sinful nature if the soul and body is ruling and not the Spirit leading. (This is the Spirit that we invited into our lives at conversion)

John 6:63— It is the spirit that quickeneth; the flesh profiteth nothing: the words that I speak unto you, [they] are spirit, and they are life.

When man becomes a new creature in Christ, he doesn't walk the same, think the same or supposed to do the same. All of his being has been instantly converted to God, but he doesn't know this. He has to learn who he is in Christ Jesus. But as soon as there was conversion, which was confession, he became a new creature. When he invited God in and he surrendered and humbles himself, repented of sin, he became a new creature in Christ Jesus. He is no longer his own, he was bought with a price. And he must learn how to glorify God. This is the new tri-part type being with a quickened spirit who is learning to be lead by God.

To change the environment of the Christian you must bring the whole body under subjection to the Spirit of God. Every aspect of the tri-part being must be governed by the Spirit.

2Corinthians 5:17—old things are passed away, behold all things are become new.

The saint must walk in the newness of mind, seeking the mind of Christ.

1Corinthians 6: 19-20—...know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own? For you are bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's.

To follow is a list of what is the flesh or carnal nature: Galatians 5:19-21 (NLT)— When you follow the desires of your sinful nature, the results are very clear: sexual immorality, impurity, lustful pleasures, idolatry, sorcery, hostility, quarreling, jealousy, outbursts of anger, selfish ambition, dissension, division, envy, drunkenness, wild parties, and other sins like these. Let me tell you again, as I have before, that anyone living that sort of life will not inherit the Kingdom of God.

Galatians 2:16 (NLT)— Yet we know that a person is made right with God by faith in Jesus Christ, not by obeying the law. And we have believed in Christ Jesus, so that we might be made right with God because of our faith in Christ, not because we have obeyed the law. For no one will ever be made right with God by obeying the law.

Galatians 3:10-14 (NLT)— But those who depend on the law to make them right with God are under his curse, for the Scriptures say, "Cursed is everyone who does not observe and obey all the commands that are written in God's Book of the Law." So it is clear that no one can be made right with God by trying to keep the law. For the Scriptures say, "It is through faith that a righteous person has life." This way of faith is very different from the way of law, which says, "It is through obeying the law that a person has life." But Christ has rescued us from the curse pronounced by the law. When he was hung on the cross, he took upon himself the curse for our wrongdoing. For it is written in the Scriptures, "Cursed is everyone who is hung on a tree." Through Christ Jesus, God has blessed the Gentiles with the same blessing he promised to Abraham, so that we who are believers might receive the promised Holy Spirit through faith.

Galatians 3:19-26 (NLT)— Why, then, was the law given? It was given alongside the promise to show people their sins. But the law was designed to last only until the coming of the child who was promised. God gave his law through angels to Moses, who was the mediator between God and the people. Now a mediator is helpful if more than one party must reach an agreement. But God, who is one, did not use a mediator when he gave his promise to Abraham. Is there a conflict, then, between God's law and God's promises? Absolutely not! If the law could give us new life, we could be made right with God by obeying it. But the Scriptures declare that we are all prisoners of sin, so we receive God's promise of freedom only by believing in Jesus Christ. Before the way of faith in Christ was available to us, we were placed under guard by the law. We were kept in protective custody, so to speak, until the way of faith was revealed. Let me put it another way. The law was our guardian until Christ came; it protected us until we could be made right with God through faith. And now that the way of faith has come, we no longer need the law as our guardian. For you are all children of God through faith in Christ Jesus.

You must be born again, accepting the redemptive work of Jesus on the cross and receiving Him as Lord and Savior. When you do so, God deposits His Holy Spirit in you.

Galatians 4:4-7 (NLT)— But when the right time came, God sent his Son, born of a woman, subject to the law. God sent him to buy freedom for us who were slaves to the law, so that he could adopt us as his very own children. And because we are his children, God has sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts, prompting us to call out, "Abba, Father." Now you are no longer a slave but God's own child. And since you are his child, God has made you his heir.

Galatians 5:16-17 (NLT)— So I say, let the Holy Spirit guide your lives. Then you won't be doing what your sinful nature craves. The sinful nature wants to do evil, which is just the opposite of what the Spirit wants. And the Spirit gives us desires that are the opposite of what the sinful nature desires. These two forces are constantly fighting each other, so you are not free to carry out your good intentions.

The Spirit referenced in the preceding scriptures, is the Holy Spirit of God. The Holy Spirit is God, His power, His character, nature and virtue. When God fills you with His Spirit, you receive the enabling ability to reveal His characteristics, nature and virtue. The spiritual evidence that the Holy Spirit is in your life is you will manifest the fruit of the Spirit.

THIS IS SPIRITUAL EXERCISE: As we grow in the word, developing our own intimate relationship with God, through study of the word and through prayer, we will began to exhibit evidence of the fruit in our lives. If you don't work-out you will not grow!!!! The evidence will not show up without the time and dedication to detail.

There are nine fruit of the Spirit mentioned in Galatians 5:22-25—But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, meekness, temperance: against such there is no law. And they that are Christ's have crucified the flesh with the affections and lusts. If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit.

God asks us to love Him, but it is only through the enabling power of the Holy Spirit that we can do so.

Mark 12:30— And thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind, and with all thy strength: this is the first commandment.

God is love, and He demonstrated it to us by what He did for all of us.

John 3:16-18— For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life. For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved. He that believeth on him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God.

Love is a fruit of the spirit. God fills us with His enabling ability to love others.

IJohn 4:11-16 Message (MSG)— My dear, dear friends, if God loved us like this, we certainly ought to love each other. No one has seen God, ever. But if we love one another, God dwells deeply within us, and his love becomes complete in us—perfect love! This is how we know we're living steadily and deeply in him, and he in us: He's given us life from his life, from his very own Spirit. Also, we've seen for ourselves and continue to state openly that the Father sent his Son as Savior of the world. Everyone who confesses that Jesus is God's Son participates continuously in an intimate relationship with God. We know it so well, we've embraced it heart and soul, this love that comes from God.

Some people question why it is necessary to be born again. They have not accepted Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior, and feel that their character already demonstrates some of the fruit of the spirit. But consider the scriptural answers.

John 3:16-18— For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life. For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved. He that believeth on him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God.

Romans 8:5-11 (NLT)— Those who are dominated by the sinful nature think about sinful things, but those who are controlled by the Holy Spirit think about things that please the Spirit. So letting your sinful nature control your mind leads to death. But letting the Spirit control your mind leads to life and peace. For the sinful nature is always hostile to God. It never did obey God's laws, and it never will. That's why those who are still under the control of their sinful nature can never please God. But you are not controlled by your sinful nature. You are controlled by the Spirit if you have the Spirit of God living in you. (And remember that those who do not have the Spirit of Christ living in them do not belong to him at all.) And Christ lives within you, so even though your body will die because of sin, the Spirit gives you (eternal) life because you have been made right with God. The Spirit of God, who

raised Jesus from the dead, lives in you. And just as God raised Christ Jesus from the dead, he will give life to your mortal bodies by this same Spirit living within you.

1John 2:27(NLT)— But you have received the Holy Spirit, and he lives within you, so you don't need anyone to teach you what is true. For the Spirit teaches you everything you need to know, and what he teaches is true—it is not a lie. So just as he has taught you, remain in fellowship with Christ.

1John 4:6 (MSG) — My dear children, you come from God and belong to God. You have already won a big victory over those false teachers, for the Spirit in you is far stronger than anything in the world. These people belong to the Christ-denying world. They talk the world's language and the world eats it up. But we come from God and belong to God. Anyone who knows God understands us and listens. The person who has nothing to do with God will, of course, not listen to us. This is another test for telling the Spirit of Truth from the spirit of deception.

Galatians 6:7-8 (NLT)— Don't be misled—you cannot mock the justice of God. You will always harvest what you plant. Those who live only to satisfy their own sinful nature will harvest decay and death from that sinful nature. But those who live to please the Spirit will harvest everlasting life from the Spirit.

Change Your Position

You change your position when your healing, well-being, deliverance, favor, or promotion is the result of proper thinking or the right attitude regarding a person, place or circumstance. When you have the right perception (thought process), you will speak words of faith and confidently implement the right action plan.

The following are examples of people who shifted from victims to victorious because they changed their posture, changed their atmosphere, changed their environment and ultimately changed their position.

The Naomi & Ruth experience

Naomi's husband and two sons die while living in Moab. She and her two daughters-in-law were widowed and consequently experience a change of provision. They decide to move back to Bethlehem. Their negative circumstances necessitated a change of environment.

Ruth 1:5-6— And Mahlon and Chilion died also both of them; and the woman was left of her two sons and her husband. Then she arose with her daughters in law, that she might return from the country of Moab: for she had heard in the country of Moab how that the Lord had visited his people in giving them bread.

Ruth speaks words to set herself up for victory. She decides not to go back to her country and family but follow Naomi instead. This is a purposeful decision to change her environment.

Ruth 1:16-17— And Ruth said, Intreat me not to leave thee, or to return from following after thee: for whither thou goest, I will go; and where thou lodgest, I will lodge: thy people shall be my people, and thy God my God: Where thou diest, will I die, and there will I be buried: the LORD do so to me, and more also, if ought but death part thee and me.

When Naomi returns to Bethlehem, she is greeted by friends in a delightful atmosphere. They are happy to see her, but Naomi speaks out of her condition of bitterness caused by grief. She blames the Lord for her affliction and her words change the climate.

Ruth 1:19-21— So they two went until they came to Bethlehem. And it came to pass, when they were come to Bethlehem, that all the city was moved about them, and they said, Is this Naomi? And she said unto them, Call me not Naomi, call me Mara: for the Almighty hath dealt very bitterly with me. I went out full, and the LORD hath brought me home again empty: why then call ye me Naomi, seeing the LORD hath testified against me, and the Almighty hath afflicted me?

Ruth goes to work and winds up on the field of Boaz. This becomes a change of her condition.

Ruth 2:1-3— And Naomi had a kinsman of her husband's, a mighty man of wealth, of the family of Elimelech; and his name was Boaz. And Ruth the Moabitess said unto Naomi, Let me now go to the field, and glean ears of corn after him in whose sight I shall find grace. And she said unto her, Go, my daughter. And she went, and came, and gleaned in the field after the reapers: and her hap was to light on a part of the field belonging unto Boaz, who was of the kindred of Elimelech.

Ruth changes her posture. Remember, to change posture is to connect, attract and commit to God. Ruth is rewarded for her loyalty, faith and diligence. She obtains favor from Boaz.

Ruth 2:8-16 (NLT)— Boaz went over and said to Ruth, "Listen, my daughter. Stay right here with us when you gather grain; don't go to any other fields. Stay right behind the young women working in my field. See which part of the field they are harvesting, and then follow them. I have warned the young men not to treat you roughly. And when you are thirsty, help yourself to the water they have drawn from the well." Ruth fell at his feet and thanked him warmly. "What have I done to deserve such kindness?" she asked. "I am only a foreigner." "Yes, I know," Boaz replied. "But I also know about everything you have done for your mother-in-law since the death of your husband. I have heard

how you left your father and mother and your own land to live here among complete strangers. May the LORD, the God of Israel, under whose wings you have come to take refuge, reward you fully for what you have done." "I hope I continue to please you, sir," she replied. "You have comforted me by speaking so kindly to me, even though I am not one of your workers." At mealtime Boaz called to her, "Come over here, and help yourself to some food. You can dip your bread in the sour wine." So she sat with his harvesters, and Boaz gave her some roasted grain to eat. She ate all she wanted and still had some left over. When Ruth went back to work again, Boaz ordered his young men, "Let her gather grain right among the sheaves without stopping her. And pull out some heads of barley from the bundles and drop them on purpose for her. Let her pick them up, and don't give her a hard time!"

Ruth's posture changes her position. She changed her posture to earn prominent position for generations after her.

Ruth 4:13-22— So Boaz took Ruth, and she was his wife: and when he went in unto her, the LORD gave her conception, and she bare a son. And the women said unto Naomi, Blessed be the LORD, which hath not left thee this day without a kinsman, that his name may be famous in Israel. And he shall be unto thee a restorer of thy life, and a nourisher of thine old age: for thy daughter in law, which loveth thee, which is better to thee than seven sons, hath born him. And Naomi took the child, and laid it in her bosom, and became nurse unto it. And the women her neighbours gave it a name, saying, There is a son born to Naomi; and they called his name Obed: he is the father of Jesse, the father of David. Now these are the generations of Pharez: Pharez begat Hezron, And Hezron begat Ram, and Ram begat Amminadab, And Amminadab begat Nahshon, and Nahshon begat Salmon, And Salmon begat Boaz, and Boaz begat Obed, And Obed begat Jesse, and Jesse begat David.

Ruth's position has favorable effects on Naomi. Ruth's position changed Naomi's position as well.

Ruth 4:14-17— And the women said unto Naomi, Blessed be the LORD, which hath not left thee this day without a kinsman, that his name may be famous in Israel. And he shall be unto thee a restorer of thy

life, and a nourisher of thine old age: for thy daughter in law, which loveth thee, which is better to thee than seven sons, hath born him. And Naomi took the child, and laid it in her bosom, and became nurse unto it. And the women her neighbours gave it a name, saying, There is a son born to Naomi; and they called his name Obed: he is the father of Jesse, the father of David.

Daniel's experience

Daniel was brought from Jerusalem to Babylon as a war prisoner. War changed his environment.

Daniel 1:1-2— In the third year of the reign of Jehoiakim king of Judah came Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon unto Jerusalem, and besieged it. And the Lord gave Jehoiakim king of Judah into his hand, with part of the vessels of the house of God: which he carried into the land of Shinar to the house of his god; and he brought the vessels into the treasure house of his god.

Daniel, although a prisoner, is given favor. The prominent position he held spiritually caused a change in the environment for him in Babylon.

Daniel 1:3-6— And the king spake unto Ashpenaz the master of his eunuchs, that he should bring certain of the children of Israel, and of the king's seed, and of the princes; Children in whom was no blemish, but well favoured, and skilful in all wisdom, and cunning in knowledge, and understanding science, and such as had ability in them to stand in the king's palace, and whom they might teach the learning and the tongue of the Chaldeans. And the king appointed them a daily provision of the king's meat, and of the wine which he drank: so nourishing them three years, that at the end thereof they might stand before the king. Now among these were of the children of Judah, Daniel, Hananiah, Mishael, and Azariah:

Daniel retains his posture to not defile himself. He changed the atmosphere and environment to what was beneficial for him. Daniel 1:8— But Daniel purposed in his heart that he would not defile himself with the portion of the king's meat, nor with the wine which he drank: therefore he requested of the prince of the eunuchs that he might not defile himself.

Daniel is promoted because of an excellent spirit. The atmosphere he set around himself drew favor and promotion.

Daniel 6:3— Then this Daniel was preferred above the presidents and princes, because an excellent spirit was in him; and the king thought to set him over the whole realm.

Daniel's enemies conspire against him. They attempt to change Daniel's outcome to a death sentence.

Daniel 6:5-9— Then said these men, We shall not find any occasion against this Daniel, except we find it against him concerning the law of his God. Then these presidents and princes assembled together to the king, and said thus unto him, King Darius, live for ever. All the presidents of the kingdom, the governors, and the princes, the counsellors, and the captains, have consulted together to establish a royal statute, and to make a firm decree, that whosoever shall ask a petition of any God or man for thirty days, save of thee, O king, he shall be cast into the den of lions. Now, O king, establish the decree, and sign the writing, that it be not changed, according to the law of the Medes and Persians, which altereth not. Wherefore king Darius signed the writing and the decree.

Daniel does not change his posture of dedication to prayer. He retains the atmosphere of the presence of God.

Daniel 6:10-11— Now when Daniel knew that the writing was signed, he went into his house; and his windows being open in his chamber toward Jerusalem, he kneeled upon his knees three times a day, and prayed, and gave thanks before his God, as he did aforetime. Then these men assembled, and found Daniel praying and making supplication before his God.

Daniel's environment is changed because of his enemies. He is thrown into the lion's den.

Daniel 6:16-17— Then the king commanded, and they brought Daniel, and cast him into the den of lions. Now the king spake and said unto Daniel, Thy God whom thou servest continually, he will deliver thee. And a stone was brought, and laid upon the mouth of the den; and the king sealed it with his own signet, and with the signet of his lords; that the purpose might not be changed concerning Daniel.

Daniel retains his posture of trust in God. His life is spared because he changed the atmosphere of his environment in the lion's den with the presence, power and deliverance of God. Consequently, the change of environment created a change in outcome for Daniel. He is delivered from the lion's den, his enemies and their families receive his death sentence. Daniel is promoted and prospered during the reign of two kings, Darius and Cyrus.

Daniel 6:21-22— Then said Daniel unto the king, O king, live for ever. My God hath sent his angel, and hath shut the lions' mouths, that they have not hurt me: forasmuch as before him innocency was found in me; and also before thee, O king, have I done no hurt. His adversaries punished. The king praises God. Daniel promoted and prospers And the king commanded, and they brought those men which had accused Daniel, and they cast them into the den of lions, them, their children, and their wives; and the lions had the mastery of them, and brake all their bones in pieces or ever they came at the bottom of the den. Then king Darius wrote unto all people, nations, and languages, that dwell in all the earth; Peace be multiplied unto you. I make a decree, That in every dominion of my kingdom men tremble and fear before the God of Daniel: for he is the living God, and stedfast for ever, and his kingdom that which shall not be destroyed, and his dominion shall be even unto the end. He delivereth and rescueth, and he worketh signs and wonders in heaven and in earth, who hath delivered Daniel from the power of the lions. So this Daniel prospered in the reign of Darius, and in the reign of Cyrus the Persian.

Our New Testament experience according to the Apostle Paul

Paul tells Timothy that the Word of God is for doctrine, admonition, reproof and instruction.

2Timothy 3:16— All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness.

If you had to choose only one book of the New Testament that tells you all about living a godly lifestyle, I would suggest the Book of Romans. Why is that you ask? It is because:

The Book of Romans lets us know who we are. It defines the Kingdom Environment we should dwell in.

Romans 1:3-8— Concerning his Son Jesus Christ our Lord, which was made of the seed of David according to the flesh; And declared to be the Son of God with power, according to the spirit of holiness, by the resurrection from the dead: By whom we have received grace and apostleship, for obedience to the faith among all nations, for his name: Among whom are ye also the called of Jesus Christ: To all that be in Rome, beloved of God, called to be saints: Grace to you and peace from God our Father, and the Lord Jesus Christ. First, I thank my God through Jesus Christ for you all, that your faith is spoken of throughout the whole world.

Romans 6:1-11— What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin, that grace may abound? God forbid. How shall we, that are dead to sin, live any longer therein? Know ye not, that so many of us as were baptized into Jesus Christ were baptized into his death? Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life. For if we have been planted together in the likeness of his death, we shall be also in the likeness of his resurrection: Knowing this, that our old man is crucified with him, that the body of sin might be destroyed, that henceforth we should not serve sin. For he that is dead is freed from sin. Now if we be dead with Christ, we believe that we shall also live with him: Knowing that Christ being raised from the dead dieth no more; death hath no more dominion over him. For in that he died, he died unto sin once: but in that he liveth, he liveth unto God. Likewise

reckon ye also yourselves to be dead indeed unto sin, but alive unto God through Jesus Christ our Lord.

Romans 7:4-6— Wherefore, my brethren, ye also are become dead to the law by the body of Christ; that ye should be married to another, even to him who is raised from the dead, that we should bring forth fruit unto God. For when we were in the flesh, the motions of sins, which were by the law, did work in our members to bring forth fruit unto death. But now we are delivered from the law, that being dead wherein we were held; that we should serve in newness of spirit, and not in the oldness of the letter.

The Book of Romans informs us of our access and what we have. And that is access to communion and fellowship with God and Kingdom inheritance/benefits. It defines the Kingdom Atmosphere.

Romans 5:1-11— Therefore being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ: By whom also we have access by faith into this grace wherein we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God. And not only so, but we glory in tribulations also: knowing that tribulation worketh patience; And patience, experience; and experience, hope: And hope maketh not ashamed; because the love of God is shed abroad in our hearts by the Holy Ghost which is given unto us. For when we were yet without strength, in due time Christ died for the ungodly. For scarcely for a righteous man will one die: yet peradventure for a good man some would even dare to die. But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us. Much more then, being now justified by his blood, we shall be saved from wrath through him. For if, when we were enemies, we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son, much more, being reconciled, we shall be saved by his life. And not only so, but we also joy in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, by whom we have now received the atonement.

We are told what we are to do to live godly and pleasing to God. It defines our Kingdom Posture.

Romans 2:17-20— Behold, thou art called a Jew, and restest in the law, and makest thy boast of God, And knowest his will, and approvest the things that are more excellent, being instructed out of the law; And art confident that thou thyself art a guide of the blind, a light of them which are in darkness, An instructor of the foolish, a teacher of babes, which hast the form of knowledge and of the truth in the law.

Also Read: Romans Chapter 12 through Romans Chapter 15

The Book of Romans tells us about the law of the Spirit and what the Holy Spirit accomplishes in, on and through us. It defines our Kingdom Position.

Romans 8:1-39 (NLT)— So now there is no condemnation for those who belong to Christ Jesus. And because you belong to him, the power of the life-giving Spirit has freed you from the power of sin that leads to death. The law of Moses was unable to save us because of the weakness of our sinful nature. So God did what the law could not do. He sent his own Son in a body like the bodies we sinners have. And in that body God declared an end to sin's control over us by giving his Son as a sacrifice for our sins. He did this so that the just requirement of the law would be fully satisfied for us, who no longer follow our sinful nature but instead follow the Spirit. Those who are dominated by the sinful nature think about sinful things, but those who are controlled by the Holy Spirit think about things that please the Spirit. So letting your sinful nature control your mind leads to death. But letting the Spirit control your mind leads to life and peace. For the sinful nature is always hostile to God. It never did obey God's laws, and it never will. That's why those who are still under the control of their sinful nature can never please God. But you are not controlled by your sinful nature. You are controlled by the Spirit if you have the Spirit of God living in you. (And remember that those who do not have the Spirit of Christ living in them do not belong to him at all.) And Christ lives within you, so even though your body will die because of sin, the Spirit gives you life because you have been made right with God. The Spirit of God, who raised Jesus from the dead, lives in you. And just as God raised Christ Jesus from the dead,

he will give life to your mortal bodies by this same Spirit living within you. Therefore, dear brothers and sisters, you have no obligation to do what your sinful nature urges you to do. For if you live by its dictates, you will die. But if through the power of the Spirit you put to death the deeds of your sinful nature, you will live. For all who are led by the Spirit of God are children of God. So you have not received a spirit that makes you fearful slaves. Instead, you received God's Spirit when he adopted you as his own children. Now we call him, "Abba, Father." For his Spirit joins with our spirit to affirm that we are God's children. And since we are his children, we are his heirs. In fact, together with Christ we are heirs of God's glory. But if we are to share his glory, we must also share his suffering. Yet what we suffer now is nothing compared to the glory he will reveal to us later. For all creation is waiting eagerly for that future day when God will reveal who his children really are. Against its will, all creation was subjected to God's curse. But with eager hope, the creation looks forward to the day when it will join God's children in glorious freedom from death and decay. For we know that all creation has been groaning as in the pains of childbirth right up to the present time. And we believers also groan, even though we have the Holy Spirit within us as a foretaste of future glory, for we long for our bodies to be released from sin and suffering. We, too, wait with eager hope for the day when God will give us our full rights as his adopted children, including the new bodies he has promised us. We were given this hope when we were saved. (If we already have something, we don't need to hope for it. But if we look forward to something we don't yet have, we must wait patiently and confidently.) And the Holy Spirit helps us in our weakness. For example, we don't know what God wants us to pray for. But the Holy Spirit prays for us with groanings that cannot be expressed in words. And the Father who knows all hearts knows what the Spirit is saying, for the Spirit pleads for us believers in harmony with God's own will. And we know that God causes everything to work together for the good of those who love God and are called according to his purpose for them. For God knew his people in advance, and he chose them to become like his Son, so that his Son would be the firstborn among many brothers and sisters. And having chosen them, he called them to come to him. And having called them, he gave them right standing with himself. And having given them right standing, he gave them his glory. What shall we say about such wonderful things as these? If God is for us, who can ever be against us? Since he did not spare even his own Son but gave him up for us all, won't he also give us everything else? Who dares accuse us whom God has chosen for his own? No one—for God himself has given us right standing with himself. Who then will condemn us? No one—for Christ Jesus died for us and was raised to life for us, and he is sitting in the place of honor at God's right hand, pleading for us. Can anything ever separate us from Christ's love? Does it mean he no longer loves us if we have trouble or calamity, or are persecuted, or hungry, or destitute, or in danger, or threatened with death? (As the Scriptures say, "For your sake we are killed every day; we are being slaughtered like sheep." No, despite all these things, overwhelming victory is ours through Christ, who loved us. And I am convinced that nothing can ever separate us from God's love. Neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither our fears for today nor our worries about tomorrow not even the powers of hell can separate us from God's love. No power in the sky above or in the earth below—indeed, nothing in all creation will ever be able to separate us from the love of God that is revealed in Christ *Iesus our Lord.*

Spending time to study the Book of Romans, will catapult your relationship with God to new levels. But read every book of the Bible so you will be able to pray and speak affirmations over your life. The following chapter has affirmations that address many facets of life and circumstances. They reflect what God says about you, about your access to Him, and access to kingdom promises. Open your mouth to speak your kingdom language—the scriptures. Change your posture, your atmosphere, your environment, to change your position. God the Father is waiting for you to connect with Him. Attract Him to you with your prayers of thanksgiving, supplication, praise, worship, intercession and affirmations. And you will shift your life from victim to victorious in Christ Jesus.

I keep my head lifted up, my ear gates open wide, and the door to my heart always open so that your word will have free course to enter in. Your word fills my mind so that every thought or imagination that exalts itself against your knowledge is cast down. Therefore my mind is transformed and renewed by your word. Speak to me with your voice so I can hear you accurately, precisely and distinctly. The seed of your word enters my heart abundantly. Out of that abundance, I speak your truth with the mouth and wisdom that the adversary can not gainsay nor resist. Your glory endures forever and because you rejoice in your works, I shall praise your name forever Lord. For you alone are excellent and your glory is above the heavens and the earth.

Righteousness

Psalm 106:3 — Blessed are they that keep judgment, and he that doeth righteousness at all times.

My Lord I desire to live a righteous life before you. Even if I suffer for righteousness sake, I have a joyful heart. I am not afraid of the things or the elements that bring terror, nor is my spirit troubled. I flee from the influences that hinder a lifestyle of holiness, righteousness, godliness, faith, love, patience and meekness. I am dead to the cares of this world because my life is hid with Christ in God. For you Jesus Christ are my life and when you appear, I will appear with you also in glory. I stand for goodness, righteousness and truth, therefore I keep myself hedged and guarded by your Spirit. Righteousness establishes me. I thank you for keeping me far from oppression, fear and terror. I hunger for your word and thirst after your Spirit so I am able to deny my flesh. I take up my cross daily and earnestly follow you.

Your word says that those who hunger and thirst after right-eousness shall be filled. So as I seek after the kingdom of God and your righteousness first and foremost, all things that are needed and necessary for my life are added to me. I am found in you, not lifting up my own righteousness, but having my faith in Christ and the righteousness of God. I do not walk in the counsel of the ungodly, nor stand in the way of sinners, nor sit in the seat of the scornful. I delight in your law and meditate in it day and night. Each day I seek and see your face and I present myself, body, soul and spirit as a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to you Lord which is my reasonable service. And I follow after the things that make for peace and helps me to exhort, edify and comfort others. Your kingdom Lord is not the natural things like meat and drink, but your kingdom is your righteousness, peace and joy in the Holy Ghost.

1Peter 3:14, 1Timothy 6:11, Colossians 3:3-4, Ephesians 5:9, Ephesians 6:14, Isaiah 54:14, Luke 9:23, Matthew 5:6, Matthew 6:33, Philippians 3:9, Psalm 1:1-2, Psalm 27:8, Romans 12:1, Romans 14:17, Romans 14:19

Presence of the Holy Spirit Anointing

Psalm 92:10 — But my horn shalt thou exalt like the horn of an unicorn: I shall be anointed with fresh oil.

Thank you Father for the infilling and anointing of your Holy Spirit. Your word says that the anointing of your Spirit will teach me all things that are truth and not lies and reveal Jesus Christ. As I am taught, your presence abides with me and in me. Your holy presence transforms and renews my thoughts, my words, my actions, my entire lifestyle. By your Spirit, every burden is taken off my shoulders and every yoke from off my neck. Because of your anointing the yoke is destroyed, and your Spirit is upon my life to share glad tidings to the meek, to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to all those who are held in captivity, and open prison doors for those who are bound emotionally, physically and spiritually.

As I abide in your Spirit, you prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies and they shall see you anoint my mind with your wisdom, knowledge and understanding. Thank you for causing my cup and everything you place into my life to run over with blessing. I align my heart to yours to love righteousness and hate wickedness, so that I am anointed with your exceeding joy and gladness. Thou shalt seek them, and shalt not find them, even them that contended with thee: they that war against thee shall be as nothing, and as a thing of nought.
